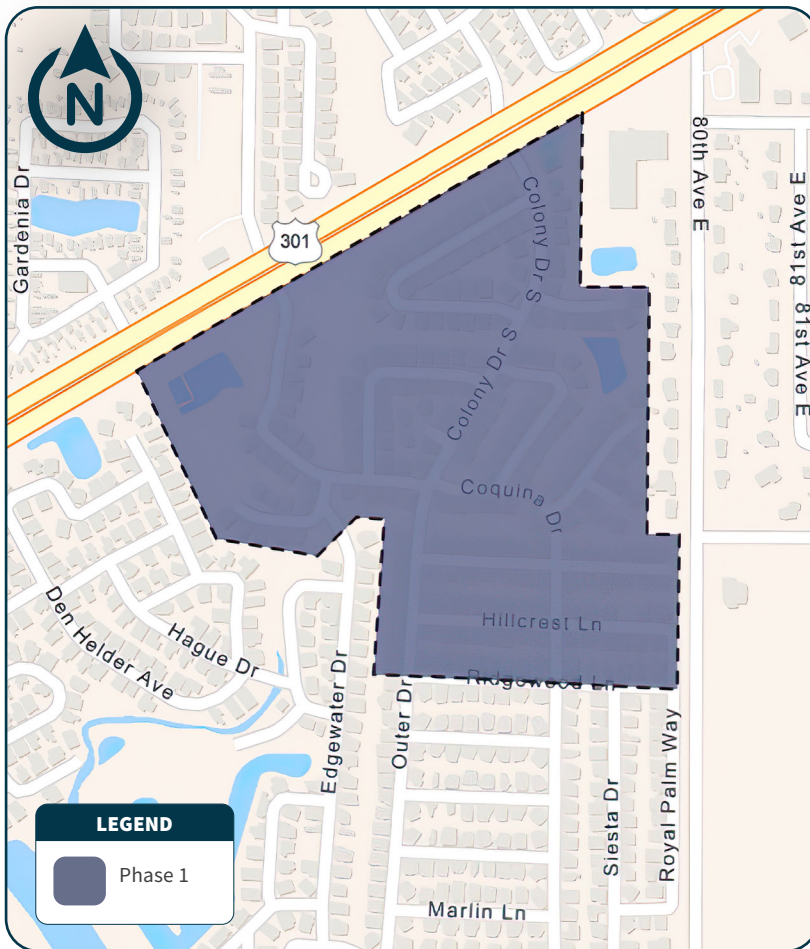






PROJECT INFORMATION

The Manatee County Public Works Department is designing and constructing a new wastewater collection system to replace the existing sewer system within Colony Cove. This project will occur in three phases with Phase 1 beginning south of US 301 in the vicinity of Colony Drive and Hillcrest Lane. Phase 1 construction activities include installation of a new lift station, sanitary sewer manholes, sewer mains and lateral pipelines to individual residences. The new wastewater collection system will eliminate the intrusion of stormwater and groundwater into the system, which is occurring in the existing system. When this happens, it creates added stress to the County's wastewater treatment plant by increasing the volume of water needing treatment. A new potable water system will be installed at the same time the County's wastewater collection system is being constructed.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

-  Activities will primarily take place Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
-  Driveway and roadway access to be coordinated with residents as needed during construction.
-  Heavy equipment will generate noise during these activities.
-  No interruptions to waste collection, mail or other deliveries are anticipated.

ANTICIPATED COST AND CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

-  **Estimated Total Construction Project Cost:** \$12.5 million
-  **Estimated Start of Construction:** Late Spring 2024
-  **Estimated Construction Completion:** Late 2025
